NSEA will fund one (1) UPS Diversity Scholarships for administrators to attend our professional development trainings provided at the national meeting to be held in Portland, ME on October 21-25, 2012.

Applications will be accepted from institutions designated by the United States Department of Labor, Office of Small Business Programs (OSBP), as Minority Colleges and Universities at www.dol.gov/osbp/programs/mcu.htm. These institutions include Historically Black College and Universities (HBCU), Hispanic Serving Institutions (HSI) and Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCU). Each institutional grant recipient will receive the \$385 registration fee, \$278 SEE Training registration fee, \$125 annual membership dues credit, hotel and travel expenses. *Preference will be given to new member institutions, members who have not been able to attend a conference in the past, and institutions with no funding available for professional development.*
