NSEA encourages the professional development of its members by offering Student Employment Essentials (SEE) training. These sessions are designed to teach the skills necessary to run a successful student employment office and provide a framework to sharpen existing skills and acquire new ones. With the help of a grant from the United Parcel Service (UPS), NSEA is pleased to offer financial assistance to members wishing to participate in SEE training but who lack the necessary funding to do so. Recipients will be designated as “UPS Scholars”.

The UPS Scholarship will cover the registration fees for recipients to participate in this year’s pre-conference Student Employment Essentials training sessions being held October 21 and 22 in Portland, ME. Each scholarship will cover the registration fees for Track A and/or Track B. Expenses related to any travel, hotel, meal, conference fee, or personal expenses are excluded.

In order to be considered, applications must include applicant and supervisor names.

Recipients will be notified by August 3, and reminded to complete their NSEA Conference & SEE Training Registration Form by the early bird deadline, if they have not already done so.
